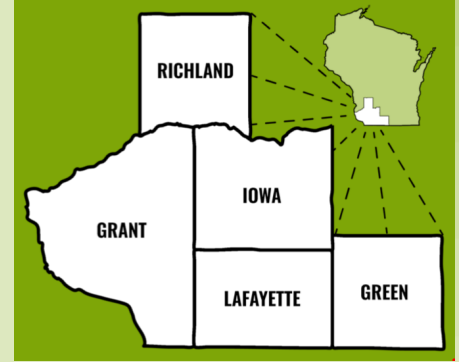

OUR PARTNERSHIP consists of five county coalitions with representation from multiple sectors, guided by a steering committee.
